



ENGINEERING EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD 2018 NOMINATION FORM

INSTRUCTIONS:

Each UEC member society may submit one nominee for Engineering Educator of the Year 2018. **Previous winners may not be nominated again.**

The Nomination Package must:

1. **Be received by December 31, 2017.**
2. Submit the nomination package in PDF format.
3. Each nomination must be accompanied by a **letter of recommendation** from the sponsoring professional society.
4. Each nomination must include a **summary of accomplishments** (not to exceed 200 words), the winner of which to be read at the 2018 UEC Awards Banquet.
5. Include a high resolution picture of the nominee.

Additional documentation may be included that support nomination. Please provide the nomination package in the form of the outline shown below.
