



## FRESH FACES OF ENGINEERING AWARD 2018 NOMINATION FORM

The UEC New Faces of Engineering Award recognizes the accomplishments of young engineers by highlighting their engineering accomplishments and their contributions to our communities. The purpose of the award is to recognize our young professional engineers by:

- (1) Spotlight new faces in the engineering profession
- (2) Recognize a group of young, diverse and talented engineers, thereby portraying engineering as an exciting profession
- (3) Provide incentive for college engineering students to explore the variety of career options in engineering as well as encouraging high school students to study engineering in college.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

The Utah Engineers Council will accept nominations and make a selection to be recognized at the Engineers Week Banquet in February 2018. Only one nomination per engineering society is allowed. **Previous winners may not be nominated again.**

### Nominees must:

1. Hold an undergraduate degree from an ABET accredited engineering college or university within the last five years **no earlier than January 1, 2012.**
2. Be employed as an engineer between two to five years in the State of Utah.
3. Have been involved in projects that improve public welfare or further professional development and growth. The projects may be completed as part of a team at the engineer's place of employment or through any other professional or civic affiliation.

**The Nomination Package** with all the required information below must:

1. Submitted in PDF format to the Awards Committee Chair, David Cline, at the contact information shown at the bottom of this form by **December 31, 2017.**
2. Include in the nomination package a high resolution picture of the nominee.
3. Each nomination must be accompanied by a **letter of recommendation** from the sponsoring professional society.

Additional pages to this form can be used. Feel free to include résumés, letters of recommendation (3 maximum) from peers and associates, and other information about the candidate's professional and civic activities.
